Here is the final report for this regional meeting. We took in \$1157.41 since our last meeting in February 2010. After business today and paying all of our bills, we ended our session 1052.48 under our prudent reserve.

Matt C. (Vice Chair) and I went through all of the bank statements from November 2009 through March 1020. We discovered that "Your Message Center" had been making two withdrawals from our account since January 2010, our normal withdrawal of \$90.00, plus an additional withdrawal of \$95.00. Matt called and spoke with Shawn, who handles our account. She reported that they did have another account whose bill was \$95.00 per month. Because it was a Saturday, there was nothing she could do. It was decided that Matt, Bill and I would go to the bank on Monday to discuss the issue with them.

5/3/10 Update

We met at the bank and were informed that the bank could not go back any further than 60 day to credit our account. While we were at the bank we also discovered that an additional withdrawal of \$95.00 had been made for April. That makes the total \$380.00 of unapproved drafts that have been applied to someone else's account. Following that the bank called Shawn at "Your Message Center" to see what our options were. Shawn had already contacted their bank and was awaiting a response from them.

5/7/10 update

Matt spoke with Shawn at "Your Message Center" today. Shawn reported that an error had occurred with our and a few other of their other accounts resulting in the "double withdrawal" and the bank would be wire transferring the \$380.00 back to our account today. Matt checked with the bank and the money had been wired, however; we were also charged \$15.00 for receiving the wire. Matt is planning on going to the Bank next week to discuss this issue. He will report on the results of this discussion at the next Regional meeting.
