I've created a "mouse tail" and placed it on the Calendar pages only. It is several multi-colored NA service symbols with the NA logo on the end. The movement of your mouse makes the tail bounce and stretch along behind it. I also created NA service and NA logo icons which appear in the address line of your browser and as the designated icon associated with each page that is placed in your favorites.

Activities have been added as requested and removed when they are over and graphics have been added to the listing of activities. Changes to meetings that have been requested through e-mail communication and from the Phoneline listing have been posted.

The statistics server is operating and has much information at our avail. Once again, I will try to report in further detail at the next RSC once I've had a chance to study it in a little more depth.

The page to NA site links is up and running. There is a disclaimer regarding these links being monitored periodically to ensure that they do not contain any non-NA links and that removal will occur if found in violation.

I incorrectly reported eleven e-mail accounts having been set up for each of the **RSC Administrative Committee members and the RSC Subcommittees** in my last report. There are actually thirteen. Although I distributed the user id and password for each position or committee to all but three of these trusted servant positions, only one has been accessed to date. Please don't make the WebMaster/Administrator responsible for checking your mail. The accounts were set up in an effort to foster communication in the Arkansas Region as well as a source of contact for others inside and outside the fellowship. Don't forget that links to your e-mail accounts have been placed on the RSC pages of <arscna.org> and that anyone, anywhere and at any time may attempt contact through these links. As a reminder to those this concerns, please, be sure to log-on to your e-mail accounts periodically, test out how to use it and if you have any trouble accessing or maneuvering within these accounts, please feel free to contact me. I'm here to serve.

I mentioned that I am in the process of purchasing the Adobe Acrobat program to convert files to PDF for posting to the site. PDF Writer software is not compatible with Windows XP and that's what my new computer runs on. But, the general consensus was for the RSC to purchase the software for use by the WebMaster. Also discussed was the purchase of supplies necessary to fulfill the duties of the WebMaster position. A motion for ink and paper was made and one will be forthcoming regarding a budgeted amount to be set.

Thank you all for the numerous kudos received during our Website Discussion and throughout the weekend. I am most humbled by them. Several items of interest were discussed and I am grateful for all the input received. It was decided that the RSC Guidelines and Minutes be made available on the site. Concerns regarding members' addresses and phone numbers within the minutes were discussed and as I set to this task, they will be excluded. An archive of past RSC minutes will be posted in the future as time permits.
