Hello Family!

Our domain registration expired without notification. Although I updated the hosting company, AIT, with my new personal e-mail back in May 2001, it did not get updated with NameIT, which became AITDomains and therefore, notification was lost in cyberspace. Our site was completely down for about 18 hours. I re-registered the domain and got the site back up and running. I was unable to ascertain how long the registration would be for or the cost -- I only gleaned that the cost would be discounted because it is a renewal -- the charges have yet to hit my credit card statement. I will be following up with AITDomains support/billing teams for the full story, which, hopefully, I will be able to report at the next RSC.

Activities have been added as requested and removed when they are over and graphics have been added to the listing of activities. Changes to meetings that have been requested through e-mail communication and from the Phoneline listing have been posted. The minutes for the February and March 2002 RSCs have been posted. All last names, personal phone numbers, addresses and e-mail addresses have been removed from the original text. The guidelines file has not yet been received from the former RSC Secretary, so we are still awaiting the file for both updating the guidelines and posting them to the site.

In the past several months, I have promised detailed reporting on the statistics compiled by our STATS SERVER -- all I can say at this point is that the numbers keep churning out in the 250+ range weekly for hits to the <arscna.org> domain.

RSC Administrative Committee members and the RSC Subcommittees don't forget to access your e-mail accounts occasionally. The accounts were set up in an effort to foster communication in the Arkansas Region as well as a source of contact for others inside and outside the fellowship. Don't forget that links to your e-mail accounts have been placed on the RSC pages of <arscna.org> and that anyone, anywhere and at any time may attempt contact through these links. As a reminder to those this concerns, please, be sure to log-on to your e-mail accounts periodically, test out how to use it and if you have any trouble accessing or maneuvering within these accounts, please feel free to contact me at webadmin@arscna.org. I'm here to serve.

The Adobe Acrobat program to convert files to PDF for posting to the site has been received, on my computer and registered to ARSCNA. I found it for less money and have returned the unspent \$28.10 to the ARSCNA Treasury. It's working great! Also purchased were the ink cartridges and paper as set forth in another motion during last session of the RSC.
