
It was brought to my attention that we may be practicing copyright infringement by posting map graphics generated by Expedia and MapQuest websites on our <arscna.org> web pages. Research proved this to be true so all graphic maps have been removed from the site. Expedia strictly prohibits posting any of their generated maps, however, MapQuest does offer a free direct link capability that specifically states that links must not target opening in a new browser window. This is the way the maps are now posted to our site; however, I am researching different possibilities as the current method does exhibit advertising.

Another change that is forthcoming is a cascading menu on all pages. This will allow users to go anywhere on the site without having to go back to any the main pages. The cascading menu is similar to the drop-down menus found on the menu bar [file, edit, view, etc.] of most software programs used today. This will be a major change to the look of the site and it may be several months before implementation occurs.

Our domain registration from May 2002 through April 2003 was billed at 99¢ and charged to my personal credit card. This is the only way we can pay for annual registration at this time. A motion for reimbursement will be submitted today since this is not a budgeted expense at this time.

RSC Administrative Committee members and the RSC Subcommittees don't forget to access your e-mail accounts occasionally. The accounts were set up in an effort to foster communication in the Arkansas Region as well as a source of contact for others inside and outside the fellowship.
