Speakers include founding and influential members of NA; some of whom helped start the first meetings; were personal friends of Jimmy K; and helped pen our invaluable literature. The conference will be recorded on CD which will then be made available to any addict anywhere interested in the history of Narcotics Anonymous.

Focused on carrying a strong message of recovery, this conference will be an intensive exploration of the legacy of Narcotics Anonymous, taking place over three days, and packed with addicts sharing their inspiring experience, strength, and hope. By learning about our history, we develop a more grounded sense of what NA is about and gain an appreciation for the struggles we went through to get where we are today.
